	Vision: Leaders who	Areas of Focus
Prayer	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Want to pray• Have an established pattern or rhythm of prayer they feel confident in• Are aware of and draw upon a range of approaches to prayer• Are comfortable in seeking guidance in their praying	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Rhythms of prayer/different prayer approaches (e.g. contemplative /journaling/art/intercessory/liturgical)• Spiritual direction
Rhythms	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Are finding a rhythm or rule in their lives that enables them to live free, full, sustainable lives• Are able to identify and adapt patterns or habits in their lives	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Concept of 'habit'• Audit of their habits and how they are affecting their loves
Self-awareness	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Love themselves well; who can bring Gospel truths to bear on their own life, and who know where to find life• Who know their strengths, limitations and particular giftings• Can increasingly articulate their purpose or calling	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Psychometric testing (and discussion around this)• Storytelling and sharing• Mentoring• Journaling and self-reflection

Vision	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Have vision- both macro (What is God up to in His world?) and micro (therefore what should we do here and now?)• Can articulate this vision so as to captivate and inspire others	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• How to create and sustain vision – testimonies from leaders
Organisation	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Are able to be organised so as to get the best out of themselves and others	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• How to structure time• Personal admin and use of diary• Top-tips from leaders and TED talks
Listening	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Listen to others well and as a matter of priority	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Active listening skills – pastoral counselling• Advice from professional listeners• Time to practice this
Speaking	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Can present ideas in a confident, imaginative and captivating manner	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Training in public speaking and presentation skills• Attempting a TED talk and feedback

Bible	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Have a good grasp of what the Bible is and contains• Are developing a Biblical imagination and the ability to think 'biblically' in new situations• Are confident in reading/speaking about the Bible with others	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• What is the Bible?• Biblical overview: biblical theology (creation through to new creation – NT Wright's 5 act play)• Deeper (exegetical) study of a few pieces of scripture• How to lead a Bible study• Biblical theology of leadership
Theology	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Are confident in articulating the central truths of the historic Christian faith in a range of contexts• Are developing a theological imagination: able to read their experiences in light of theology and make wise judgements• Are aware of and recognise some of the broad theological streams in the tradition	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Doctrines: Trinity/ Atonement/ Church – The Creeds• Key Christian thinkers that they might feel comfortable reading again (Augustine/Luther/Barth/Bonhoeffer/Sayers/Hauerwas/NT Wright)• Christian ethics – how Christians might make ethical decisions
